**Jury comments:** "This project succeeds at all levels, from its site planning and overall conceptual clarity, to its meticulous proportioning and resolution of the smallest detail. There is an economy and beauty in the execution of these simple farm structures that transforms them into something much greater. While the project's palette is disciplined and limited to ordinary construction methods and off the shelf materials, the execution of these materials at the detail level is exquisite. The design focuses on a few distinct material moments, such as the bamboo lattice wall, while keeping the overall forms and organization of the complex simple and purposefully utilitarian."
